What's the percentage of graduates who have jobs at the time of graduation and/or are going to grad school?

What is the average starting salary for graduates of this program?

What are the internship/co-op opportunities like from this department? Clinical or research or other practical experiences?

What specializations or tracks are available to students in these academic programs?

How many students are in this department?

Ask a Student

Why did you select this university?

What is your favorite thing about this university?

What is your least favorite thing?

Is it easy to get involved with student organizations?

What is the largest class you've ever had/smallest?

What is the student life like?

Did you live in the dorms? Did you enjoy them?

If you could do it all over again, would you select this university?

How is the on-campus food?

Do you feel safe? What is campus security like?

Are there any campus jobs available?

Do you have any advice for me?
